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### **mLINQS And AS&M Form Partnership To Compete For DHS Contracts**

**FAIRFAX, VA – (May 12, 2009)** – mLINQS, LLC today announced that the company has formed a second partnership with Analytical Services & Materials, Inc. (AS&M), headquartered in Hampton, Virginia, to compete for new federal contracts under the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) EAGLE acquisition program. DHS EAGLE (Enterprise Acquisition Gateway for Leading Edge Solutions) is an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracting vehicle that enables DHS to procure information technology solutions and commodities agency-wide.

mLINQS and AS&M will compete in the small business category for Operations and Maintenance contracts with AS&M as the prime vendor. Since its inception in 2006, DHS EAGLE has awarded 297 IT contracts valued at \$6.8 billion across its 18 components and offices.

According to AS&M vice president Dom Mullori, “Our company has made a significant investment to expand the technology services and expertise we can offer federal agencies. In mLINQS we have an experienced partner headquartered in the Washington, DC area that can quickly and efficiently identify new business opportunities from which we can both benefit.”

“Over the past year, we’ve built a close relationship with AS&M,” said mLINQS president Greg McIntyre. “This is the second partnership for our two companies, which now enables us to compete together in a major civilian agency, as well as in the Department of Defense.” mLINQS and AS&M formed their first partnership in 2008, and have begun to compete for contract awards under the U.S. Navy’s SeaPort-e program.

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
