mLINQS APPOINTS GRAHAM McINTYRE CEO

FAIRFAX, VA – (June 8, 2005) – mLINQS™, LLC today announced that Graham W. McIntyre, one of the company's founding investors, has been appointed Chief Executive Officer. McIntyre served previously for over 18 years as the Director of Research and Resources with The George Washington University (GWU) School of Engineering and Applied Science.

Prior to his distinguished career at GWU, Graham McIntyre served 23 years as an officer in the U.S. Army, completing his service with the rank of Colonel. His service included a tour of duty in Viet Nam as a Battalion Commander.

“mLINQS recently released a new relocation application for federal employees that piqued my interest,” said Graham McIntyre. “During my Army career, I received PCS (Permanent Change of Station) orders ten times. From experience, I know how disruptive and often painful relocation can be, particularly when you add the complexity of government regulations to the mix. I believe the mLINQS product will help relieve much of the anxiety of moving for transferees and their families. At the same time, it will reduce the costs associated with relocation for both civilian agencies and the Department of Defense. It's a win-win proposition.”

mLINQS relocation is the first fully automated system for end-to-end government relocation expense management. Early adopters are the Department of the Treasury and the Bureau of Public Debt. McIntyre will take a hands-on role in the day-to-day corporate management of mLINQS and will serve as senior counsel for policy. He was graduated from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point with a Bachelor of Science degree and earned his Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Southern California.
