### **mLINQS Wins Multiple Award Navy IDIQ Contract**

**FAIRFAX, VA – (June 2, 2008)** – mLINQS, LLC today announced that the company has been awarded an IDIQ (indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity) contract by the U.S. Navy under the SeaPort-e acquisition program. The Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Surface Warfare Center is the contracting activity.

Government estimates indicate that a maximum of \$5.3 billion of services will be procured per year as a result of orders issued under the SeaPort-e program. The program has awarded multiple award contracts to approximately 1,605 companies, 340 of which were included in this latest admission to the program.

There are 22 functional service areas within the scope of the IDIQ. Of them, mLINQS expects to compete in at least five areas:

- Software Engineering, Development, Programming, and Network Support
- Configuration Management (CM) Support
- Quality Assurance (QA) Support
- Information System (IS) Development
- Functional and Administrative Support

mLINQS, via its servLINQ government services and support division, with its seven subcontractor partners, will compete for contracts across four of the Navy's seven geographic zones nationwide. Of note is that the company and its subcontractors are already providing support services to the Department of the Navy.

The current IDIQ contract contains provisions to set aside task orders that further level the playing field for small and minority owned businesses within their zone or zones of performance. mLINQS qualifies under these provisions as a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business. mLINQS subcontractors also qualify in other areas, such as women-owned, 8(a) certified, and minority-owned enterprises.
