### **Agriculture Department Awards mLINQS Contract For Relocation Expense Management System**

**FAIRFAX, VA – (August 6, 2009)** – mLINQS, LLC today announced the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has awarded the company a contract to install its moveLINQ<sup>®</sup> government relocation expense management system. Plans call for USDA to use moveLINQ to manage the expenses associated with relocating as many as 5,000 employees each year.

“This contract award is particularly gratifying because USDA set such high standards and expectations for the system,” said Greg McIntyre, mLINQS president. “The Department of Agriculture ranks as one of the top four agencies in the federal government in terms of relocation volume.”

moveLINQ<sup>®</sup> was developed in-house by mLINQS staff, and was originally released for general availability in 2004. The system was designed to fill a void that previously existed for a relocation expense management system designed solely for government users. Today, mLINQS remains the only company to successfully develop and market a totally functional government relocation expense management system. moveLINQ is currently used to support relocation for more than 30 federal agencies, including programs managed by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Treasury Bureau of Public Debt.
